

**How do I reserve a picnic pavilion at Freedom Park?**

Reservations for Freedom Park picnic pavilions should be made a minimum of three days in advance. Reservations are only accepted on the North Highlands Recreation & Park District website: [www.nhrpd.org](http://www.nhrpd.org)

**Payments, Refunds, and Transfers...?**

Full payment is required at the time of reservation. Refund requests must be made in writing and be received fifteen (15) days prior to your reservation date to qualify for a refund or transfer date. Any refund request submitted to the District less than fifteen (15) days before the reservation date will be reviewed on a case-by-case bases. No refunds will be issued due to inclement weather. If, due to unforeseen circumstances, a cancellation is initiated by North Highlands Recreation & Park District, the reservation holder will be given a full refund.

**What does the rental include?**

Reservation hours are from dawn to dusk. Park pavilion rental includes the pavilion, picnic tables, and BBQ's. All other amenities are open for public use, i.e., playground, splash pad, basketball court, restrooms, etc.

**When is the splash pad on?**

The splash pad is turned on for public use the first weekend in May through the last weekend in September from 12:00pm-7:00pm. To activate the splash pad, press the button on top of the bee.

**What if I arrive to my picnic rental and someone else is in the pavilion?**

You should have your rental permit handy, you can print it out or have it on your phone. Politely inform the patrons that you have the pavilion rented for this day and ask that they leave. If there are any issues regarding this, you are encouraged to call the Fulton/El Camino Police Department for assistance (916) 874-5115.

**What rules do picnic renters have to follow related to COVID-19?**

All current county, state, and federal guidelines, restrictions, and protocols should be followed at all times. Including but not limited to, social distancing mandates, mask requirements, cohort sizes, and household restrictions.

**Are structures and attractions such as bounce houses & tents permitted?**

Attractions and structures such as: temporary tents, awnings, dunk tanks, bounce houses, pony rides, live bands, amplified sound, and carnival booths are not permitted.

**Can alcoholic beverages be consumed?**

Alcohol may be safely and responsibly consumed by person(s) 21 years and older. **Glass bottles and other glass containers are strictly prohibited.**

**Do the pavilions have access to water and power?**

There is no access to running water and power.
