The Position

Under general supervision of the Recreation Supervisor and/or Recreation Superintendent, provides instruction and control over designated sport, game, or competition. Directs start, duration, and conclusion of scheduled games. Enforced established rules set forth by District.



Essential Functions

- Impartially presides over competitive game play in designated sport, with or w/o partner.
- Enforces rules as set forth by District, explaining infractions or rule violations to participants in order to understand the error and avoid further infractions.
- Ensures safe play and a safe play environment for participants.
- Maintains control of the game, participants, coaches, managers, and spectators.
- Reports hazards, vandalism, incidents, and accidents to Recreation Supervisor immediately and reports proper reports as required.
- Officiates in a quality, consistent, and impartial manner at all times.
- Must be of sound mind, and good moral character
- Must be responsible and enjoy working with people of all ages.

Ability To:

- Communicate effectively verbally and in writing.
- Work harmoniously with fellow employees and the public.
- Work under stressful and sometimes difficult circumstances and be able to handle sensitive situations when they arise.
- Problem solve issues for the public and with Recreation staff.
- Must have own equipment, shirt, shorts/pants, and whistle at all times.
- Must be able to maintain a professional attitude at all times.
- Must be a team player.

Working Conditions

- Indoor and outdoor environments.
- Exposure to heat, cold and occasional inclement weather.
- Some irregular work hours, including evenings and weekends.
